The NOLA FOR LIFE REENTRY PROGRAM is now  
**NOLA FOR LIFE RISE.**

The City of New Orleans, with assistance from reentry and workforce partners, has created a comprehensive workforce reentry strategy to provide wraparound social services, training and education opportunities, employment opportunities and community supports to those returning from incarceration.



The City of New Orleans has formal partnerships with case management and support services providers. Participants in the program receive training, certifications and wraparound services.

All participants are tied to employment opportunities through job developers and through the City's Economic Opportunity strategy and partners.



# OUR PRIORITY:

As part of NOLA FOR LIFE, the initiative focuses on those most likely to either be victims or perpetrators of murders as well as those most likely to reoffend and reengage the criminal justice system. That includes:

- **Men and Women aged 16-35 years old**
- **Who have committed a felony**
- **With limited educational attainment – H.S. Diploma or less**
- **That have spent time either on probation or incarcerated**
